## TENS OF THOUSANDS BENEFIT FROM EFO PROGRAMS

A new grant from the P&G Fund expands Imagine Engineering and EFO donors support engineering education in Ohio

It was a year of exciting news and big program numbers for the Engineers Foundation of Ohio.

EFO successfully secured a very special grant from The P&G Fund of the Greater Cincinnati Foundation to expand Imagine Engineering to include Ohio's Spanish-speaking second graders.

Thanks to the P&G Fund grant, "We have produced the Spanish translation of

our original Imagine Engineering video," said EFO Past President Aurea Rivera. The new video

features Rivera translating in Spanish to share many important and exciting things different kinds of engineers do in their daily work. The video also shows several engineering demonstrations (i.e., simple and compound machines, paper airplanes and more)

with the addition of Spanish subtitles.

"This generous grant also reinforces the Imagine Engineering program in Dayton," Rivera said.

The Imagine Engineering program — now available in English and Spanish — encourages second graders'

> educational pursuits and works to spark real interest in engineering careers.

"We are *thrilled* to extend our gratitude to The P&G Fund of the Greater Cincinnati Foundation," Rivera said. But there's more: "The American Electric Power Foundation increased its giving to become a

Platinum Sponsor in 2023," said EFO President Tina Sutermeister, MBA, PE, FNSPE. "And so many others generously gave financial support and their time to help EFO advance engineering education — and STEM education — for an estimated 21,000 Ohioans."

In 2023, EFO enjoyed its largest ever attendance at both the Fall CPD Conference and December Seminar with hundreds attending each program. Similarly, the Engineer As Leader training enjoyed its second largest attendance in the last three decades.

For all three EFO CPD programs, large audiences (including a growing number of out-of-state PEs) praised EFO for timely managerial, technical and ethical seminars featuring experts in their fields.

In just one year, EFO's Imagine Engineering registrations have grown more than 157 percent

from 5,425 students in 2023 to 8,537 in 2024 (to date).

Ohio MATHCOUNTS numbers are holding steady with 1,238 middle school students served at local competitions in 2023.

In the spring of 2023, EFO awarded engineering scholarships to six new Ohio students. When these students were starting college last fall, EFO was busy promoting its 2024-2025 scholarship program, which is offering more than \$31,000 to Ohio's brightest students. By February 15, EFO's annual scholarship application deadline, the Foundation had received 172 applications from 68 students!

Yes, for the Engineers Foundation of Ohio, 2023 was a great year with a great deal to celebrate.

The Ohio team, led by Coach Anne Ramsay of Walnut Hills Middle School, came in 19th place at the national finals, and two Ohioans ranked among the top 50 students in the country.

## DECEMBER SEMINAR EFO's 'AI Frontier' seminar earns rave reviews from engineers





EFO brought back Ray Waite, MS, PMP<sup>®</sup>, to lead EFO's December Seminar, "Navigating the AI Frontier," training for Ohio PEs interested in the transformative AI technology that has swiftly evolved into an indispensable tool for engineering firms. The December Seminar, worth 6.0 CPD hours and six credits towards Project Management Professional (PMP<sup>®</sup>) certification or its renewal, was both virtual and interactive.

An engineering leader in the business commerce and telecom industries, Waite facilitated discussions on identifying and mapping a business' AI needs, how AI revolutionizes innovation, who is responsible if/when AI fails, pitfalls to avoid, experimentation, and introducing AI to engineering teams. He also presented a one-hour subsection on ethics, which included a discussion on laws and public policies pertaining to AI. Dr. Dennis Ong, a TEDx speaker on AI and an executive at a Fortune 5 company, joined Waite for the 2023 webinar to discuss key AI breakthroughs, AI "winters," the future of AI, and generative AI, including opportunities and challenges. In 2022, Dr. Ong received three patents on AI, 5G, and autonomous vehicles, and his team demonstrated the world's first 5G autonomous vehicle.

Several hundred PEs participated in EFO's 2023 Fall CPD Conference to earn 15 CPD hours. In technical and managerial seminars, participants learned about automation of agricultural field machinery, geotechnical aspects of Pittsburgh's new "floating" park, how technological changes to drilling domestic oil and gas impacted the world's economy, Ohio EPA projects, lessons learned from a natural disaster, and much more. In Ohio-mandated ethics seminars, Conference participants learned about ethical advantages of trust-based partnering and a forensic study in ethics pertaining to the May 2020 cascading dam failures in Michigan.

EFO has heard it said many times: "I rely on the EFO for low-cost, quality CPD hours."
