Legislative Update

In addition to the water reservoirs legislation (House Bill 29) and piping materials selection legislation (House Bill 214/Senate Bill 95) mentioned in *Toledo Engineer* last quarter, OSPE Board of Directors took positions on four other bills. One of these bills is House Bill 75 (professional licenses). According to *OhioEngineer* 2017 Volume 77, Issue 1, this bill would "establish an expedited process to grant a professional license to an individual who is on active duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States, or is the spouse of such an individual, and holds a valid license in another state. (OSPE opposes the "license by endorsement" provision impairing Ohio's ability to protect the public.)" OSPE also opposes Senate Bill 43 (building codes), which would enable limited home rule townships to adopt building codes regardless of any similar codes adopted by the county in which the township resides. Additional information regarding legislation which OSPE is monitoring is provided in the referenced OhioEngineer magazine.
