The Northwest Regional water treatment plant is at the tail end of two-year, 45.5-million-dollar upgrade, adding treatment capacity as well as nanofiltration softening. This was a design-build project with an owner's agent and joint venture design-build team using state revolving loan funds. This combination resulted in a unique project environment and challenges, as well as specific advantages to the design process. The presentation will give the story of the plant upgrades, with specific emphasis on the unique challenges of a design-build project in a system catered to traditional construction processes.

Randy Gilbert, PE, MPA, serves as the deputy director at Greene County Sanitary Engineering with over 42 years of experience in water supply & sanitation and has been a registered Ohio PE for nearly 38 years. Previously Randy worked at Montgomery County Environmental Services for 30 years before working at Preble County in the interim. Tristan Mull, MS, has almost 4 years of experience at Greene County Sanitary Engineering as an engineer. Prior to employment at Greene County, Tristan attended Ohio University receiving bachelor's and master's degrees, both in Civil Engineering.

## Imagine Engineering 2025 – Another Successful Contest

The Imagine Engineering Coloring Contest for 2<sup>nd</sup> graders has been completed for 2025. This was a very successful year for the contest. Locally, the Franklin County Chapter saw 44 registrations. This list represented 41 schools with approximately 1,800 students. Participants included schools in Columbus, Dublin, Reynoldsburg, Lancaster, Columbus Grove, Galloway, Hilliard, Logan, Union Furnace, Mt. Vernon, Fredericktown, Marion, Chillicothe, Circleville, Newark, Dresden, Duncan Falls and Zanesville. State-wide, the registrations totaled 10,000 students.

The option for requesting a presentation by an FCC-OSPE member was made available to the registered teachers. Franklin County Chapter volunteers made presentations to 38 classes of those teachers requesting in-person presentations. Teachers also had the opportunity to have their class view an online video produced by EFO. The teachers were very appreciative of the presentations.



There were 430 contest entries received from the classes within the Franklin County Chapter area. Judging of these entries produced the "top three" for the chapter. The top three entries are:


James Owens from St. John's Lutheran School in Marysville
